Village hall extension unveiled

WILTSHIRE county council chairman Bill Moss, accompanied by his wife, Natalie, cut a ribbon to officially open an extension to Landford village hall last Friday.

The extension was built in response to requests by users, including the nearby primary school, for additional storage space for sports equipment.

Fifty per cent of the cost of the project

was funded by Cleaning Services Group, with £19,750 of landfill tax credits supplied through Community First. There were further grants from Salisbury district and Landford parish councils.

More than 2,000 people a year use the village hall, which was opened in December 1993 by Salisbury MP Robert Key.
